Haryana Tourism (HTC) is committed to providing high quality services, consistently and constantly improving the services for the satisfaction of the visitors.

Objective

Haryana Tourism Corporation (HTC) invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from suitable and experienced bidder/firms for enabling the Pre-paid wallet services **in Point of Sales and Online Room Booking System (ORBS)**. The main objective of this EOI is to provide the alternative digital payment services to the visitors visiting Tourist Resorts of Haryana Tourism.

HTC plans to extend web/app based Online Room Booking facility through “Payment Service Provider” [PSP]/”Pre-paid payment Instruments [PPI]” which should allow as a storage device to electronically load all physical payment forms (credit card, debit card, NetBanking and e-wallets etc.). Users should be able to register all/one digital payment mechanisms, in single app/solution.

PSP/PPI should preferably be having Pre-Paid Wallets, as are easy to load with multiple top-up options. Conveniently tap to pay purchases with certain merchants.

PSP/PPIs issuers have been issuing prepaid payment instruments in the country. In the emerging scenario, it is imperative to have

Eligibility Criteria:

The Bidder must have sufficient technical expertise and requisite experience provide the services for payment through:

- i) Internet Payment Gateway
- ii) Mobile App
- iii) Any Other method of Payment, if any suggested (Details can be enclosed)

The following are the conditions, which are to be necessarily fulfilled, to be eligible for evaluation of the proposal, only those interested bidders who fulfill the terms & conditions as set out below, should respond to this EoI:

1. (i) The Bidders should be Indian Company(s)/Indian Citizen registered under the Indian Companies Act, and/or any other legal entity registered in Indian Law.
(ii) Bidder should submit the documents as per Annexure-2 and this EoI
2. A bidding firm should be a single entity corporation/company. Consortium of the companies/corporations/firms.
3. The bidding firm/(s) should have an annual turnover or at least last 12 months average turnover (till 31st Jan. 2017) of ₹25 Crore (Rupees Twenty Five crore only), in this regard a certificate from a Chartered Accountant (CA) firm should be submitted along with proposal.
4. The bidder should not have been Black listed by any PSU/PUC/Corporation/Board or State/Central Government in India. In this regard an affidavit must be submitted duly attested by the notary.
5. The bidder should submit an undertaking on their letterheads to the fairness of these documents in support of their claim while submitting the proposal.
6. The bidder should not have been involved in any major litigation against any Citizen/PSU/PUC/Corporation/Board or State/Central Government in India.
7. The bidder should have at least 2 years of experience in E-Wallet aggregation business with at least One live merchants in Government Sector.
8. To enable this facility, HTC will require the assistance of an Payment Service Provider [PSP]/ Pre-paid payment

Instruments [PPI] having approved by RBI, under Payment & Settlement Act 2007 and amended time to time. A certificate be submitted with EOI.

Scope of Work & Functionality:

1. The Payments from customers in the form of E wallet/M Wallet/ Electronic Form or QR Code through an app based mobile Phone or Similar device at various Point of Sales and be integrated with Web Based Integrated Software.
2. HTC online room bookings developed by National Informatics Centre, Haryana through various PPIs (Pre-paid payment instruments) channels) to be integrated with, to facilitate payments from any credit/debit card, NetBanking and prominent e-wallets The solution must be integrated with the Haryana Tourism Website for Payment Gateway transactions. Now when customers want to make the transaction, he/she will go to HTC site, login into the system, select the payment option for payment like net banking, credit card/debit card or PPI as payment option. The facility must have all the security measure and PCI-DSS certification as required by credit/Debit card/Net Banking transactions through internet. Selecting Prepaid Payment Instrument Issuers for Room Booking Payment.
3. PSP solution must be PCI-DSS certified, including The login-page and solution must prompt the customers to enter the PIN of the prepaid cards in a secured environment. The amount equivalent to Room Booking payment will be debited from any payment source.
4. In the above case the customer is immediately intimated of the success /failure of the transactions and an electronic acknowledgement of payment is displayed. (The customer is then returned from the payment Gateway interface to the HTC site – thereupon Haryana Tourism will also inform the customer about the successful completion of the online payment and issue him an acknowledgement/ receipt etc.)
5. PSP solution must not force the consumers to download any application. It should be optional for the consumers to download any application, even in the case of QR code scan.

6. Haryana Tourism's designated outlets must also be allowed to accept payments, using PSP solution; in case the consumer is not available for face-to-face transaction; example: booking payments to be made from the comfort of the consumer, asynchronously.
7. PSP/PPI solution must support asynchronous link-based collect requests. Such requests may send over an SMS or email, as provided by the consumer.
8. Integration with SMS gateways and sending of such emails, shall be sole responsibility of the PSP/PPI.
9. PSP/PPI must also support virtual-account based digital collection and automated reconciliation platform for corporate and bulk bookings.
10. PSP/PPI shall have to generate, print and supply QR codes for all outlets or provide an online facility, using which such QR codes may be re-generated/re-printed on demand.
11. PSP/PPI solution must support Android, iOS and Windows devices.
12. PSP/PPI QR code based solution must not mandate any application, for the consumer to make the payment.
13. The successful bidder should provide the transaction details/reconciliation through MIS Portal.
14. HTC receives the corresponding credit on max. T+1 days on the basis of successful/failed transactions.

Solution Security

PSP solution must have following security attributes:

1. PSP solution must NOT be hosted on any cloud. It is mandatory for the PSP to have a physical data-center with an operation DR site.
2. Data communication must be in encrypted format, either with private keys or must be certified for PCI-DSS compliance.
3. PSP "MUST" have a real-time H2H integration with an Indian Bank for Nodal Account arrangement, if PSP is other than a bank itself.

General Terms and Conditions:

1. The terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed/change in law in accordance with the laws of India and the State of Haryana.
2. HTC will not assume any liability and will not be made party in ANY dispute regarding the successful bidder's services in any court of law. In case, HTC is made party in any dispute, all kind of responsibility related to that dispute shall be borne by the successful bidder.
3. The Successful Bidder must indemnify and hold harmless the HTC against any or all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, costs, penalties etc.
4. Amendments, No change or modification in the terms and conditions shall be valid unless the same is in writing and signed by the Parties hereto.
5. Letter of Acceptance and Work Order should be canceled, if the successful bidder fails to sign the agreement within a month.
6. The successful bidders should not make the Publicity of their company in premises after taking a written consent from HTC and for placing a Logo of Haryana Tourism in their publicity campaign successful bidder should take a necessary approval in advance.
7. The Successful bidders should inform the promotional Scheme in advance and take necessary approval time to time. However, the promotional schemes launched by company for customers also be applicable to Haryana Tourism Customers.

Presentation

The selection process would involve short listing of eligible applicants on the basis of documents and detailed write up submitted by them. The shortlisted applicants will be required to give a working demo on the date (s) to be intimated later.

Performance Security Deposit

The Successful bidder will pay a Performance Security Deposit of Rs 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand only) with HTC in the form of a demand draft (DD) drawn on a

nationalized bank in favor of “Managing Director, Haryana Tourism” payable at Chandigarh alongwith Expression of Interest. The performance security shall remain with Haryana Tourism during complete contract period of the project. No interest shall be payable to the successful bidder for the amount deposited as performance security.

Refund of Performance Security deposit:

The Performance Security deposit shall be refunded after two months of expiry of the term of the contract.

Contract Period

Contract period initially for one year from the date of contract award and will be extendable for six months with mutual consent.

Forfeiture of Performance Security deposit: Performance Security deposit shall be forfeited in the following cases: -

- a. When any terms and condition of the contract is breached.
- b. When successful bidder fails to commence supply or stops making the supplies or fail to provide deliverables after partially executing the purchase/ work order.
- c. Proper notice will be given to successful bidder with reasonable time before performance security deposit is forfeited.
- d. Forfeiture of performance security deposit shall be without prejudice to any other right of HTC to claim any damages as admissible under the law as well as to take such action against successful bidder such as severing future business relation or black listing, etc.
- e. Further successful bidder would be required to obtain all statutory and other approvals, licenses/clearances from the department concern required for implementing the project in the State under this Agreement.

Liquidated Damages

In case of unauthorized use or disclosure of the CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION, HTC shall be entitled to liquidated damages in the amount of ₹ 10,000/- for each such use or disclosure. Notwithstanding the right to liquidated damages, the HTC has the right to take any measures available and to claim and receive a higher amount of compensation if the HTC can prove that the actual damage sustained will exceed the amount of liquidated damages.

Event of Default

The following events shall be considered as Event of Default:

- i) If the Successful bidder fails to provide satisfactory services at the desired service level as per the EoI and this agreement.
OR
- ii) If the Successful bidder fails to perform its any obligation(s) as mentioned in the EoI & Agreement.
OR
- iii) If the Successful bidder, in the judgment of HTC has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for executing the agreement AND due to inter-alia the filing of bankruptcy proceedings against the <NAME>,

Consequences of Event of Default/Termination of Agreement

- i. HTC may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of agreement by written notice of default sent to the Successful bidder, terminate the agreement in whole or in Part in the case of Event of Default on the part of Successful bidder.
- ii. HTC may at any time terminate the agreement by giving written notice to the Successful bidder, without compensation to the Successful bidder, if the Successful bidder becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to HTC.

- iii. Where the Successful bidder fails to perform its any obligation(s) as mentioned in the EoI & Agreement.

Consequences of Termination of Agreement

In case of termination of agreement, HTC shall be entitled to:

- i) Invoke the Security Deposit and other Performance Security Deposit furnished hereunder.
- ii) Right to use in perpetuity and composite rights to all processes as has been developed and to deal with the said processes in such manner that the HTC deems fit.
- iii) Nothing herein shall restrict the right of the HTC to invoke the Security Deposit and Performance Security Deposit furnished here under, enforce the Deed of Indemnity and pursue such other rights and/or remedies that may be available to the HTC under law.
- iii) The termination hereof shall not affect any accrued right or liability of either Party nor affect the operation of the provisions of this Agreement that are expressly or by implication intended to come into or continue in force on or after such termination.

Redressal of Grievances by HTC

- i) HTC shall constitute a committee comprising of persons, with proper powers and authorizations, to address the complaints of bidders that may occur prior to the entry into force of the contract.
- ii) Any bidder feeling aggrieved by any act of HTC after the submission of his bid may lodge a written complaint concerning his grievances not later than fifteen days after the announcement of the bid evaluation report.
- iii) The committee shall investigate and decide upon the complaint within fifteen days of the receipt of the complaint.
- iv) Mere fact of lodging of a complaint shall not warrant suspension of the procurement process.

- v) Any bidder not satisfied with the decision of the committee of the procuring agency may lodge an appeal in the relevant court of jurisdiction.

Disputes Resolution

HTC and Successful bidder shall make every effort to resolve disputes amicably by direct informal negotiation, any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the agreement will be settled at the level of Head of Department of HTC.

If during the subsistence of this Agreement or thereafter, any dispute between the Parties hereto arising out of or in connection with the validity, interpretation, implementation, material breach/supply or any alleged material breach of any provision of this Agreement or regarding any question, including as to whether the termination of this Agreement by one Party hereto has been legitimate, the Parties hereto shall endeavor to settle such dispute amicably and/or by Conciliation to be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or as may be agreed to between the Parties. The attempt to bring about an amicable settlement is considered to have failed as soon as one of the Parties hereto, after reasonable attempts; which attempt shall continue for not less than thirty (30) days, gives fifteen (15) days' notice to refer the dispute arbitration to the other Party in writing.

In case dispute is not settled amicably within stipulated time, same shall be referred to the Sole Arbitrator. Both the parties agree to appoint Chairman, HTC/Chairman and Managing Director, HTC (as the case may be) as Sole Arbitrator and his awards shall be final and binding upon both the parties.

The Arbitration proceedings shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

The Arbitration proceedings shall be held in Chandigarh.

Conflict Of Interest

The Successful bidder must disclose to the HTC in writing, all actual and potential conflicts of interest that exist, arise or may arise (either for the Successful bidder himself or his Team) in the course of performing the Services as soon as practical after it becomes aware of that conflict.

Cancellation of Procurement Process

- (1) HTC may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, cancel the process of procurement initiated by it -
 - (a) at any time prior to the acceptance of the successful bid; or
 - (b) after the successful bid is accepted in accordance with sub-rules (4) and (5).
- (2) HTC shall not open any bids or proposals after taking a decision to cancel the procurement and shall return such unopened bids or proposals.
- (3) The decision of the HTC to cancel the procurement and reasons for such decision shall be immediately communicated to all bidders that participated in the procurement process.
- (4) If the bidder whose bid has been accepted as successful fails to sign any written procurement contract as required, or fails to provide any required security for the performance of the contract, the HTC may cancel the procurement process.
- (5) If a bidder is convicted of any offence under the Act, the HTC may-
 - (a) cancel the relevant procurement process if the bid of the convicted bidder has been declared as successful but no procurement contract has been entered into;
 - (b) rescind the relevant contract or forfeit the payment of all or a part of the contract value if the procurement contract has been entered into between the procuring entity and the convicted bidder.
- (6) A procurement process, once cancelled, shall not be reopened. However, this shall not prevent HTC from initiating a new procurement process for the same procurement, if required.

Force Majeure

Force majeure shall mean only act of God, epidemic, earthquake, landslide, volcano, eruption, floods, cyclone, lightening, war invasion, armed conflict or any other activity of foreign enemy like blockage embargo, terrorist attacks and any other unforeseen natural disaster beyond the control of human being.

For purposes of this clause, “Force Majeure” means an event beyond the control of the Successful bidder and not involving the Successful bidder and not involving the Successful bidder fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but are not restricted to, instances of, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes which would have an impact on HTC.

If a Force Majeure situation arises, the Successful bidder shall promptly notify HTC in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by HTC, the Successful bidder shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.
